How to Separate and Dispose of your Household Waste Chikuma City

Please read this flyer for information about reducing and recycling your household waste. Please adhere to these regulations. Contact the person in charge of your district or your local government office if you are unsure of the designated disposal area.

Types of Refuse

Combustible

Number of pickups ►Twice / Week

Disposal Location ►

Combustible Refuse Station



Paper waste, plastic buckets and basins, leather goods, futons, video tapes, CDs, etc

Disposal Method

- Place up to 5kg of waste in the designated refuse bag
- Drain excess liquid from food waste before disposal
- Write your name on the refuse bag




Non-combustible

Number of pickups ▶Once / Month

Non-combustible Refuse Station



Glass cups, beer bottles, bottles for cosmetics, electrical appliances weighing 5kg or less

- Place up to 5kg of waste in the designated refuse bag
- Write your name on the refuse bag



Bottles and Cans

Number of pickups ▶2 to 4 times / Month Disposal Location ▶





Cooking Oil

Used cooking oil is collected. It will be recycled into items such as soap or fuel.




Please pour your used cooking oil into containers made available at the designated site. Please remove sediments prior to disposal.

Regarding the Designed refuse Bags

There are three types of refuse bags designated by Chikuma city: 55ℓ for combustibles, 25ℓ for combustibles, and a refuse bag for non-combustibles. All are available for purchase at supermarkets and convenience stores.

Waste disposed of in bags other than designated refuse bags will not be collected. A waste processing fee of ¥40 is included in the price of each refuse bag.



Collection Days for Combustible Refuse

Combustible refuse is collected twice a week in each area. Please make sure to dispose of your refuse at the designated collection site on the appropriate collection day. Refuse is not collected on public holidays.

Holiday Stations

Holiday stations are available for those who are unable to drop off their recyclables at their local collection points due to work hours or other reasons.

These holiday stations will collect the following items:

Collected items

Bottles (clear, brown, etc.), cans, PET bottles, plastic containers and packaging, paper (newspapers, magazines, flyers, cardboard, paper cartons, paper containers and packaging), used fabric (bedding, thick winter clothes, etc. cannot be collected), fluorescent tubes, dry cell batteries, waste cooking oil

Collection dates, times, and locations are shown in the table below.* Excludes year-end and New Year holidays
